About the brigade

The Ernesto Ché Guevara Volunteer Work Brigade, an annual project of the Canadian Network on Cuba in collaboration with the Cuban Institute of Friendship with the Peoples (ICAP), promotes solidarity with Cuba in the spirit of internationalism and friendship. Since 1994, travellers from across Canada have joined the Brigade to support the heroic Cuban people in their struggle against the U.S. blockade and for their right to self-determination.

Combining education and exploration with light volunteer work, this unique opportunity allows participants to experience the real Cuba beyond beaches and resorts, witness the incredible successes of Cuban socialism firsthand, and work alongside Cubans as they continue building a community that supports all people.

Cost

Cost range is usually \$1500-1700, and includes all accommodations, meals, and activities. The final price depends on the program details and total participants. If needed, Cuban health insurance is an additional fee of \$50. Flights are booked separately.
